DIOCESE OF OSSORY SAFEGUARDING SUNDAY, WEEKEND OF 23RD/24TH NOVEMBER 2019

Next week-end, 23rd and 24th November 2019 - the Feast of Christ the King – is designated by the Church in Ossory as Diocesan Safeguarding Awareness Weekend. During the weekend the Church focuses on the importance of safeguarding children/vulnerable adults of our faith community and the importance of ensuring good safeguarding practice throughout the Diocese. Good Safeguarding practice is a priority in our parishes, our schools and in all sporting and cultural organisations.
