#### From Damascus with Love

In the second reading at Mass this weekend Paul prays that the Lord will enable the community of Thessalonica grow in love. What is this love? In fact the question should be 'who is this love? The Love Paul speaks about is not a feeling it is a real person - Jesus Christ. It is this Love with which Paul's life overflowed following his extraordinary encounter with the risen Jesus on the road to Damascus. Paul encountered Divine Love heart to heart and this proved to be the catalyst for his transformation into a missionary of love not hate. The road to Damascus became a first step for Paul on a journey of discovery that would lead him to become an energetic and enthusiastic sharer of God's Love with the people of his time and world.

#### 3 Questions for you?

As a young person have you ever had a Damascus moment (maybe not as dramatic as St Pauls!) where you really felt the loving presence of God and this had a transformative effect on your life? Where has this led you? Where are you now?

As a young person have you ever wondered who this Jesus that Paul encountered on the road to Damascus really is? Who is it that could change someone like Paul from a hater of followers of Jesus to a lover & proclaimer of the Gospel?
