Advice from Dept. Social Protection Re Pensions

If possible - never leave a gap in your contribution record - for each week of your working life have either an A Class contribution (if you work for someone else) or an S Class contribution (if you are self employed) or a social welfare credit. This is because the level of the contributory state pension is affected by the total number of credits and contributions accumulated.
