A Message from Fr Martin

Last year when I became Administrator of Durrow and Cullohill parish we had a joint meeting of the Rathdowney and Durrow Parish Pastoral Councils. Among the topics we had to discuss was a revised Mass schedule for both parishes. One of the criteria for deciding a new schedule was that I be able to celebrate one mass each weekend in either Durrow or Cullohill . Secondly, in the event of me being the only priest between the two parishes the schedule would be such that I could celebrate all the weekend Masses. This meant that there had to be an hour and a half between the two Masses on Saturday evening and again on Sunday morning.

After much debate about various options the two Parish Pastoral Councils agreed on the Mass schedule we have been operating since last year. Saturday: Cullohill at 7pm and Errill at 8.30pm. Sunday: Rathdowney at 10.30am and Durrow at 12 noon. (An extra Mass was scheduled for Durrow on Saturday evening at 7.30pm to facilitate Canon Sean O'Doherty who is retired, to able to celebrate a public Mass at weekends. When Canon Sean is not available the 7.30pm Mass on Saturday is not celebrated)

It was agreed that we would review the Mass schedule after about a year and that is now what we plan to do. There will be a joint meeting of the two Parish Pastoral Councils on Tuesday 22nd of November. In advance of that meeting, I would like all parishioners in both parishes to reflect on this issue and if you have any ideas or feedback I would be very grateful if you would contact me or any member of the Pastoral Council in either parish.

I realise that no schedule suits everyone but given the realities on the ground we have to take into consideration the needs of both parish communities. Thank you for your continued cooperation and consideration.
