The sanctuary **SUNDAY 18th February** area was completely flooded on Christmas morning. The cause of the Durrow 11.15 am: problem was the corrosion of the underground pipe system between the boiler house and the church itself. This is a problem which was probably a few years in the making and as the Insurance Company Collections Weekend 3rd / 4th January 2024 concluded it was due to 'wear and tear' they are not prepared to cover Loose Plate - € 329.50 Envelopes - €1038.50 the cost which will be in the region of €22,000. If we pay for this from Adoration our current resources, it will leave the account pretty much empty for Adoration in Cullohill Church every Thursday morning from 9 - 9.30am, all the other day to day expenses. and in Durrow directly after 8.50 am Mass (finishes at 11.30 am) on Mondays The Parish Finance Committee met last week to discuss the matter and on Fridays from 7-8pm. and the conclusion was that we should have a once off envelope collection to pay for the Heating Repairs. We have already received a number of donations including one for €500 and another for €300. This is not an appeal I like having to make, but the Parish Finance committee feels it is the best approach at this time. Thanks to some generous legacies which were left to the parish more than fifty years ago most of the capital projects in both Errill and Rathdowney Ash Wednesday - 14th February 2024 churches in recent generations have been financed without needing to undertake any particular fundraising campaigns.
